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Dear BIS Hanoi families,

Following the success of last year and in line with our school promise of Creating Your Future, we're proud to announce our scholarships programme for the 2024-25 school year. For the 2024-25 school year, we will grant scholarships focusing on a wide array of areas and expanding from Year 5 to Year 12.

Scholarships will be awarded up to 20% of tuition fees depending on the scholarship type and the results of the selection process. The scholarships are valid for 1 or 2 years. To qualify candidates will have to be either a current BIS Hanoi student committed to re-enrol in the 2024-25 SY, or an incoming 2024-25 SY applicant who has submitted all application documents and paid the application fee.

HIGH LEVEL ACER TEST OVERVIEW

PRIMARY

Reading and Viewing

- 25 multiple-choice questions
- 30 minutes

The Reading and Viewing test provides a single measure of achievement reflecting comprehension and interpretation of written and visual material from a range of curriculum areas.

Mathematics

- 20 multiple-choice questions
- 30 minutes

Students apply mathematical skills and knowledge to answer problems, including short calculations using addition, subtraction, multiplication, division.

Writing

- 2 extended responses in different genres
- 20 minutes each, 40 minutes total

Students will be assessed in terms of the quality of content and ideas, and the structure of expression.

SECONDARY

PART 1: Humanities – Comprehension and Interpretation

- 40–45 multiple-choice questions
- 40 minutes

This test asks students to answer questions related to written and visual material. The material may be drawn from subject areas such as English, Art, History, Geography and Social Studies. No specialist knowledge in these areas is assumed – all the information needed will be provided. Students are required to think critically and make judgements about different types of texts, including fiction, non-fiction, poetry, cartoons, diagrams and maps.

PART 2: Mathematics (Years 7,8), Mathematics and Science (Years 9,10)

- 32–36 multiple-choice questions
- 40 minutes

This test attempts to measure mathematical and scientific abilities rather than school achievement in these areas. The material used for the questions is selected from a wide variety of sources, and may differ from standard school-based curriculum materials.
