## YEARS 10 AND 11 [GRADES 9+10]

- Cambridge IGCSE for all subjects except English, where we follow Oxford AQA.
- Grades are awarded by Cambridge International Examinations on the scale $A^{*}$ - $G$ in all subjects except for English which are awarded 9-1.


## YEARS 12 AND 13 [GRADES 11+12]

IB Diploma Programme (IBDP).

IBDP students study 6 subjects, 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL). Final results in each subject are awarded according to the 7-point grading scale as stated by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO), in which 1 is the lowest and 7 is the highest.

A maximum of 3 bonus points is awarded for successful completion of the DP core subjects of Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and Extended Essay (EE), each of which is graded from A - E. This makes a total of 45 points.

Full participation in, and completion of, the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) core element is also required.

As a school we do not rank our students, calculate GPAs or convert IB points to other scales
