All children change their shoes when they arrive at school to indoor shoes, which need to be suitable for PE.

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ROCKETS CLUB

For parents who are unable to collect their children at 2:45pm, we offer Rockets Club to support later collection.

You can sign up to Rockets Club through Schools Buddy. There are two slots on Mondays to Thursdays, 2:45pm to 3:45pm and 3:45pm to 4:45pm. On Fridays, there is one slot 2:45pm to 3:45pm.

During the first session, children have the opportunity to participate in free play supervised by adults in the Rockets Room and other classrooms.

During the second session, we encourage the children to explore calmer activities through watching a movie or drawing and colouring.



SETTLING IN

At BISB, we aim for children to feel safe, stimulated and happy in our Early Years phase and to feel secure and comfortable with all staff. We also want parents to have confidence in their children's well-being and ability to benefit from what our Early Years has to offer.

We aim to support parents and other carers to help their children settle as quickly and easily as possible, by giving consideration to the individual needs and circumstances of each child and their families.

Some children may need longer to settle into their new routines and therefore we might suggest your child begins on half days until they have adapted to the changes. This will be discussed with you before your child starts.

We advise that when your child first starts, you ensure that you drop them off on time and collect them at 2:45pm, so that they can become used to the initial class routine before joining Rockets club.
