OVERVIEW

- Students must join the school in Yea 1 and above
- Must be eligible to study at an international school in China (i.e. hold an international passport) and not currently enrolled at NAIS Pudong
- Start dates of January 2024 (and then any time in the academic year)
- Scholarships available for up to three years, depending on entry point, and subject to annual review
