



BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD) **Grades 9-14 + 9-10 FLE**

For our 9-14 + 9-10 FLE year students, we adopt a “Bring Your Own Device” (BYOD) personal laptop policy. The reasons are as follows: Laptops are more suitable for classroom requirements. Most students already own a laptop in the upper grades and prefer to use their own device.

To ensure that learning is not disrupted at the start of the school year, it is therefore important that all students come to school ready for class with the right materials. This involves having a fully functional laptop.

An Apple computer is strongly recommended to allow students to make the most of our learning environment built around Apple technology. With a MacBook, students can connect their computer to the whiteboard to give presentations and share their files with students and teachers. You will find the specifications recommended by the IT department below.

Please ensure that each student will be equipped for the next school year by checking their device.
