Over the past 122 years, we have consistently focused on providing a well-rounded education, cultivating not only academic excellence but also personal growth, social responsibility, and a global perspective. As we continue to grow and evolve, our **mission remains unchanged: to support the development of future leaders, thinkers, and innovators.**

In light of our continued success and the increasing demand for our boarding program, Collège Champittet is pleased to announce a special opportunity aimed at **enhancing cultural diversity and attracting young talents to our community.** We are excited to offer **unique financial awards for the 2026-2027 academic year.** These awards, valued at **CHF 20,000 each**, will be applied toward the tuition fees for students enrolling in full boarding for the entire academic year (August to June).

The awards are specifically designed to foster greater cultural diversity within our student body and to attract talented individuals from a range of geographic regions determined by our Financial Award Committee (see the attached tab).

### Financial Awards Criteria

The financial awards will be granted based on the following criteria:

- **Academic Profile, Performance, and Potential:** Students should demonstrate a strong academic record, with clear potential for growth and achievement.
- **Extracurricular Activities, Hobbies, Personal Interests, and Recent Achievements:** We value well-rounded students who pursue their interests outside the classroom, including sports, the arts, leadership, and other personal passions. Students who have demonstrated excellence in areas such as sports competitions, music performances, charity projects, or other notable achievements beyond academics will be given special consideration.
- **Cultural Background and Nationality:** We are committed to creating a diverse and inclusive community and will take into account the student's cultural background and nationality when awarding financial awards.



## How to Apply

To apply for the financial awards, students should reach out to our Admissions team via email at [admissions@champittet.ch](mailto:admissions@champittet.ch), expressing their interest and providing the following documents:

- Academic reports for the last two academic years (2023-2024 and 2024-2025), as well as the current academic year's first semester (2025-2026).
- A letter from the parents outlining their intention to enroll their child at Collège Champittet and why they believe their child would benefit from our school.
- A 1.5-minute video of the student introducing themselves and answering the question, "What makes you feel special?"
- A recommendation form from a current teacher who can speak to the student's academic abilities and character.

All materials, including documents in PDF format and the video via a WeTransfer link, **should be submitted to our Admissions team by email no later than May 15, 2026**. After this date, our Financial Awards Committee will review all applications and select candidates based on the criteria outlined above. Applicants will be notified by email no later than June 1, 2025. Financial Awards Committee decisions will be final, and the motives of its decisions will not be communicated. Late applications will not be considered.

Selected students must **confirm their acceptance of the financial award by signing a formal acceptance letter no later than June 15, 2026**, and proceed with the final steps of the admissions process, supported by our Admissions team. This includes signing the acceptance letter and payment of the one-time non-refundable admission fee (CHF 2,500) and one-time security deposit (CHF 10,000).

## Conditions:

- The financial award is available to students aged 10-18 years old.
- The financial award is available to students entering Collège Champittet for the first time.
- The financial award is available to students enrolling in full boarding.
- The financial award applies to the full academic year (August to June) 2026-2027.



- The financial award is available to students holding passports from specific geographic areas, as determined by our Financial Awards Committee; please refer to the tab attached for further details.
- In the event of a dispute, the decision of the Financial Awards Committee will be final.
- All personal data submitted as part of the financial award application process will be handled in accordance with Collège Champittet's privacy policy.
