Please note, that these are exemplar Option Choices. The actual Option Choices and times in a given year are subject to demand and availability.

Graduation Requirements:

Grade 10 students should be aware that to graduate and obtain the High School Academic Diploma, at the end of Grade 12, twenty-four credits are required with at least twenty (20) in academic subjects and with minimum requirements in the following categories: English 4, Mathematics 3, Science 3, Humanities 3, Modern Foreign Languages 3 and Physical Education (PE) 1 credit.

Students should plan ahead to make sure they will fulfil the graduation requirements.

Notes:

- Students must choose a minimum of:
 - 1 Experimental Science (Biology, Chemistry, or Physics)
 - o 1 Social studies (History, Geography, Economics or Sociology)
- Students may select courses that were not followed in Grade 9, but it is advised that only a few course changes are made as they are all designed as 2-year courses.
- If students wish to study some Honours classes and/or APs in Grade 11 they must follow the same subject in Grade 10, if it is offered, and receive a grade A or B in the course at the end of the year.
- If students wish to take the IB Diploma in Grade 11 they will need to study the Sciences they wish to follow at IB in Grade 10 and, for Higher Level Sciences, will need to obtain an A- in their final grade.
- If students wish to study History in IB they will need to take History in Grade 10 and will need to obtain a minimum of B+ in their final grade.
- Foreign languages (other than French) require a minimum of 2 years prior study.
- CDL confirms students meet our diploma requirement but students/families must confirm any national or state university requirements.

Students must select one course from each of the options/electives. The same subject must not be selected more than once.
