The British International School Abu Dhabi is part of the Nord Anglia family of schools and was established on 6th September 2009. The school caters to students aged 3 - 18 and has an enrollment of over 2000 students with a teaching staff of 147. We are a non-selective coeducational school which seeks a diverse college/university-bound student body. Curriculum

English National Curriculum (FS - Year 11)

Key Stage 4 (Years 10-11): In Years 10 and 11, students sit examinations in up to eleven subjects, earning GCSE/IGCSE qualifications.

Grading:

Year 10 & 11 students are assessed using IGCSE/GCSE grades on a 9-1 & U number scale (9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1 & U = fail).

The school collaborates with pioneering institutions such as MIT and Juilliard, developing programmes that give students the skills, gualities and outlook to create their own exciting future.

IB Diploma Programme (Years 12-13)

In Years 12 and 13, students complete the IB Diploma (IBDP). Students must select three Higher Level (HL) subjects and 3 Standard Level (SL) subjects.

In addition, all IBDP students must complete the following Diploma core components: an Extended Essay, a Theory of Knowledge course and Creativity, Activity and Service.

IB examination performance in individual subjects is graded according to the following scales:

Level 7- Excellent, 6- Very good, 5- Good, 4-Satisfactory, 3 - Mediocre, 2- Poor, 1- Very poor, N-No grade awarded.

For an IB Diploma student, the total score available for all subjects is 42 points, plus an additional 3 points for the Diploma Core.

At BIS Abu Dhabi, we do not rank internally and do not calculate a GPA.


