Dear Parents,

Our Co-curricular programme is designed to enhance and complement our curriculum. Additionally, our Saturday programme is available for students and parents to participate in various activities.

We are aiming to stream our CCA programme within 3 streams to ensure that students can participate in more varied activities throughout the year. Our 3 streams we are focusing on are Creative, Active and Service Activities. This means that all students have more opportunities to experience different activities throughout the year. The quality of activities will be higher and more consistent. The programme aims to add challenge for students to own their achievements. The programme will also assist in developing stronger partner links within the Hanoi Activities Conference, Nord Anglia group and FOBISIA schools.

To achieve a holistic school experience, we encourage all students to participate in at least one CCA per block.

- Block 1 will start on **Monday 25 September 2023**. The activities will run through until **Saturday 9 December 2023**.
- Sign up will be from **Thursday 31 August 8:30** am till **Tuesday 5 September 12:00pm**. The Co-curricular programme provides a great opportunity for your child to take part and develop different facets of school life.
- Students will be asked for multiple preferences although they will be allocated to one activity per time slot. Please allocate at least 3 preferences per time slot, ensuring your child can be allocated to a CCA per day.
- Not all activities are available to all year groups, please see the descriptions in the brochure. Information on paid activities can also be found within the brochure. The sign-up process tries to ensure all students are granted a place on either their first, second or third choice of preference. Please see the application guidelines below for detailed instructions.

Application guidelines:

- All activities (free and paid) need to be selected online via **School Buddy**: <https://bishanoi.schoolsbuddy.net/>. Please select the the ISAMS Parent Portal sign in option and use the same login credentials you use to access your child's academic reports. Detailed log in guidelines have also been emailed to you.
- This term, we will use a single sign-up phase open from **Thursday 31 August 8:30** am to **Tuesday 5 September 12pm**. You will be able to make multiple choices which you then click to submit. Details of this process are attached in the email under the titles: **CCA sign up** and **Parent login** in school buddy.
- Please read the attached instructions on how to log in as parents and student login and School buddy procedures.
- Term 1 will start on **Monday 25 September 2023**. The activities will run through until **Saturday 9 December 2023**.
- After **Tuesday 5 September 12 PM**, students who have signed up for an activity



- must commit to it for the whole of the term. Children cannot swap activities.
- All choices will be allocated with a preference-based algorithm.
- If students are absent from their activity without authorization on more than one occasion, they will be removed from the activity and their place will go to a student on the waiting list

Paid Activities

- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the activity.
- Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be 'closed' and the activity name will be highlighted in red.
- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list.
- Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.
- Children wishing to take part in paid activities can make payments by transferring money to the school as soon as the child's activity is confirmed. Below are the BIS bank account details:
