









#### Dear Parents,

Our Co-Curricular (CCA) program is designed to help nurture well-rounded individuals, promoting personal growth, teamwork, and the development of various skills beyond academics.

Our programs provide opportunities for students to explore their interests, build resilience, and foster a sense of belonging within the school community. These include our Saturday program, as well as the after-school and lunchtime activities. The program will also assist in developing stronger partner links within the Hanoi Activities Conference, Nord Anglia group and FOBISIA schools.

The CCA program at BIS Hanoi is streamed to ensure that students can participate in more varied activities throughout the year. Our 3 streams we are focusing on are Creative, Active and Service Activities. This means that all students have more opportunities to experience different activities throughout the year.

All students are expected to be involved in at least one CCA per block.

#### Please note:

- Block 2 will start on Monday 22 January 2024. The activities will run until Saturday 13 April 2024.
- Sign up will be from **Wednesday 29 November 8:00** am till **Wednesday 6 December 8:00** am.
- Students will be asked for multiple preferences although they will be allocated to one activity per time slot. Please allocate at least 3 preferences per time slot. The sign-up process tries to ensure all students are granted a place on either their first, second or third choice of preference.
- Not all activities are available to all year groups. Please see the descriptions in the brochure.

- This term, we will use a single sign-up phase open from Wednesday 29
   November 8:00 am to Wednesday 6 December 8:00 am. You will be able to make multiple choices which you then click to submit.
- Please read the attached instructions on how to log in as parents and student login and School buddy procedures.
- Block 2 will start on **Monday 22 January 2024.** The activities will run through until **Saturday 13 April 2024**.
- After Friday 15 December 8:30am, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the whole of the term. Children cannot swap activities.
- If students are absent from their activity without authorization on more than one occasion, they will be removed from the activity and their place will go to a student on the waiting list.

#### **Paid Activities**

- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the activity.
- Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be 'closed' and the activity name will be highlighted in red.
- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list.
- Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.
- Children wishing to take part in paid activities can make payments by transferring money to the school as soon as the child's activity is confirmed.
