Dear Families,

At BIS Hanoi, our Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) program brings learning to life by nurturing well-rounded individuals who thrive beyond the classroom. By promoting personal growth, teamwork, and skill development, our CCAs play a vital role in shaping confident and resilient students.

To achieve a truly holistic school experience, we expect all students to engage in at least one CCA per block. We believe deeply in the value of CCA and enrichment, which align with the values of our BIS Aide Mémoire. This is what makes BIS Hanoi unique, shaping our students by providing the solid foundation they need to rise above and be recognised as global citizens.

Our diverse offerings—ranging from after-school and lunchtime activities to our Saturday program—allow students to explore their passions and interests. The program also strengthens our partnerships with the Hanoi Activities Conference, Nord Anglia network, and FOBISIA schools, ensuring continued growth and collaboration.

Block 1 begins on **Monday, 23 September 2024, and runs through Saturday, 14 December 2024.** The sign-up window is open from **18:00 PM on Tuesday, 27 August, until 18:00 PM on Friday, 30 August.** The CCA programme offers an excellent opportunity for your child to engage in and develop various aspects of school life.

During the sign-up process, students will be asked to select multiple preferences for each time slot, although they will only be assigned to one activity per slot. To ensure your child is allocated a CCA for each day, please submit at least three preferences per time slot. Note that not all activities are available to every year group, so please refer to the brochure for specific details. Information about paid activities is also included in the brochure. The sign-up system is designed to allocate students to one of their top three preferences. For further details, please refer to the application guidelines below.

Application guidelines:

- All activities (free and paid) need to be selected online via **Clipboard:** <https://portal.clipboard.app/bishanoi>. Detailed log in guidelines have also been emailed to you.
- Please read the attached instructions on how to log in as parents and student login and Clipboard procedures.
- Term 1 will start on **Monday 23 September 2024.** The activities will run through until **Saturday 14 December 2024.**
- After **Friday 6 September**, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the whole of the term. Children cannot swap activities.
- All choices will be allocated with a preference-based algorithm.
- **If students are absent from their activity without authorization on more than one occasion, they will be removed from the activity and their place will go to a student on the waiting list**
- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the



activity. Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be 'closed'

- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list. Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.

Paid Activities

Paid activities will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. **Please do not transfer any money immediately upon registration.** After the activities are confirmed, an email will be sent to inform you of the total amount that you will need to pay after we deduct any deposit that you may have at school. Secondary students will take part in residential trips in this block, so we will also adjust the fee based on the number of sessions that they missed while participating trips. In Block 1, by selecting a paid activity and paying the associated fees, you are agreeing to the school's liability waiver and agree to pay the required fee. **Payments must be made by Friday 13 September 2024, or the place will be offered to the children on a waiting list.**
