

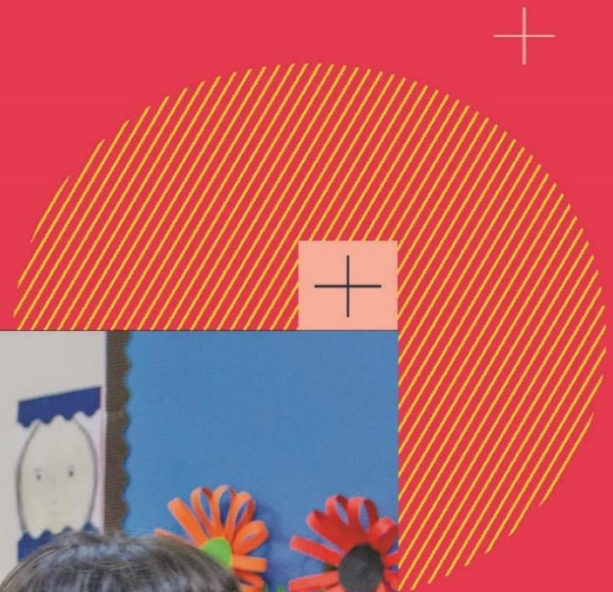

Dear Parents,

We are launching our new Co – curricular activities programme. This year the Co-curricular programme is designed to enhance and complement our curriculum. We are aiming to stream our CCA programme within 3 streams to ensure that students can participate in more varied activities throughout the year. Our 3 streams we are focusing on are Creative, Active and Service Activities. This shift will mean that all students will have more opportunities to experience different activities throughout the year. The quality of activities will be higher and more consistent. The programme aims to add challenge for students to own their achievements. The programme will also assist in developing stronger partner links within the Hanoi Activities Conference, Nord Anglia group and FOBISIA schools.

Term 1 will start on **Monday 26 September 2022**. The activities will run through until **Friday 9 December 2022**. The Co-curricular programme provides a great opportunity for your child to take part and develop different facets of school life.

Students will be asked for multiple preferences although they will be allocated to one, two or three activities only. Not all activities are available to all year groups, please see the descriptions in the brochure. Information on paid activities can also be found within the brochure. The sign-up process tries to ensure all students are granted a place on either their first, second or third choice of preference. Please see the application guidelines below for detailed instructions.

Application guidelines:

- All activities (free and paid) need to be selected online via **School Cloud** bish.schoolcloud.co.uk
- This term we will use a single signup phase which will be open from **Wednesday 31 August to Monday 5 September at 9 am**. You will be able to make multiple choices which you then click to submit. Details of this process are given below under the title: **How to select your child's activities**.
- After **Monday 5 September 9 AM**, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the whole of the term. Children will not be allowed to swap activities.
- All choices will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- If students are absent from their activity without authorization on more than one occasion, they will be removed from the activity and their place will be offered to a student on the waiting list.
- Children wishing to take part in paid activities can make payments by transferring money to the school as soon as the child's activity is confirmed. Below are the BIS bank account details:

Please include in the transfer instructions “Name of CCA” and your child’s name and class.

- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the activity.
- Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be ‘closed’ and the activity name will be highlighted in red.
- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list.
- Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.

Paid Activities

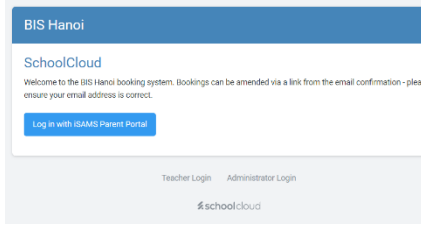

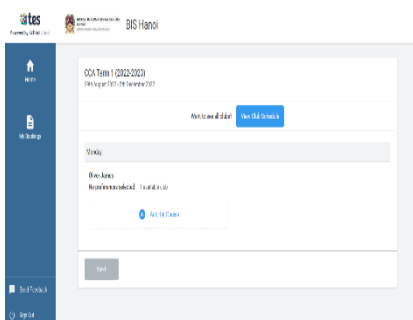
