



## WHO?

We assess all students for whom English is an Additional Language and/or whose application forms indicate less than total proficiency.

## HOW?

Placement Tests in the four skill areas of speaking, listening, reading and writing for students in Years 1-13. Placement Tests in only speaking and listening for students in Years 1 and 2. Students are assessed using the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
