NAE EXPEDITION: MOUNT MERU

FEBRUARY 2024

This expedition combines a challenging trek up Mt Meru, a rewarding service project in the local community with one of our partner charities, and a fascinating 2-day safari through the beautiful Tarangire National Park. Mt Meru is the second-highest mountain in Tanzania, enriched with the unique flora and fauna of the mountain. During the trek, you will travel through various landscapes, from dense forests to rocky terrain, culminating in the summit at 4,565m above sea level. In addition to this, you will take part in a service project, which will be designed to promote sustainable development and cultural exchange. You will work alongside local people to address community needs, such as capacity building in local primary schools or supporting families in the local community. Finally, the expedition will include a 2-day safari in Tarangire National Park. This park is home to a diverse range of wildlife, including large herds of elephants, giraffes, zebras, antelopes, and various big cat species. You will have the opportunity to experience the incredible wildlife up close through game drives, led by experienced guides. This expedition is designed to challenge you physically and mentally, while also providing opportunities for community engagement and environmental awareness.

NAE: SERVICE LEARNING TANZANIA

Working alongside one of our partner charities in Tanzania, our student s will engage in highly rewarding program m es of sustainable service work, to improve the health and long-term prospect s of children and their families in the region. This year will see student s work with multiple project partners across the same site; our main project will be providing new educational facilities with Seeway Tanzania, whilst additional project s could include engaging with Umoja to provide sport s coaching and facilities for the school, or with ECHO in developing sustainable agriculture areas around the school to provide much needed healthy meals for the pupils and teachers. Student s build confidence, independence and leadership skills. They work as part of a team to manage their own time and develop resilience, persistence and resourcefulness. They also develop a real sense of international mindedness. Before and after the w eek long experience, students engage on the Global Cam pus online platform, where they fundraise and prepare for the trip. The Tanzania expedition is a fantastic opportunity to experience not just the culture and challenges faced in Tanzania, but also to meet fellow Nord Anglia student s from around the world and build lifelong friendships. The trip includes a two-day educational safari through the Tarangire National Park, identifying and learning about some of the region's diverse flora and fauna.

Participants will develop several skills throughout this process, including but not limited to: public speaking, negotiation, teamwork, leadership, and policy crafting.

Eligibility

Applicants must be 13 years of age or older and enrolled in a high school. College students are not eligible to apply for HMUN.

Small Delegations

Small Delegations: Schools with 9 or fewer students are considered small delegations. Students in small delegations may find themselves in the Economic and Social Council & Regional Bodies, and the Specialized Agencies.

Large Delegations

Schools with more than 9 students are considered large delegations. Students in large delegations may find themselves in all three committee types - the General Assembly, the Economic and Social Council & Regional Bodies, and the Specialized Agencies. Please keep in mind that schools may receive no more than two General Assembly assignments.

2) IF I HAVE MULTIPLE CHILDREN ACROSS THE MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL WILL I BE ABLE TO RECEIVE A SIBLING DISCOUNT ON TRIPS?

- YES, THE FIRST CHILD WILL BE FULL PRICE, THEN A 2.5% DISCOUNT FOR THE 2ND CHILD, 5% FOR THE 3RD CHILD AND 10% FOR THE 4TH CHILD

3) DURING AN 'OPTIONAL TRIP' WHAT DO THE STUDENTS WHO REMAIN AT SCHOOL DO?

- TYPICALLY, STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE THEIR NORMAL EDUCATION, IF THERE IS A SMALL NUMBER REMAINING, STUDENTS WILL BE PROVIDED WITH A CONDENSED CURRICULUM, BUT WILL STILL BE IN TAUGHT LESSONS.

4) HOW DO YOU DECIDE WHICH STAFF MEMBERS CHAPERONE TRIPS?

- THERE IS AN APPLICATION PROCESS FOR TRIP LEADERSHIP. STAFF MEMBERS ARE SELECTED BASED ON EXPERIENCE, ROLE IN SCHOOL AND THE TIMING OF THE TRIP

5) ARE STAFF TRAINED TO CHAPERONE TRIPS?

- YES, STAFF RECEIVE TRIP LEADERSHIP TRAINING BOTH INTERNALLY AND FROM EXTERNAL PROVIDERS.

6) HOW IS THE PRE-TRIP INFORMATION DISSEMINATED?

- ALL RESIDENTIAL TRIPS WILL HAVE A 'PRE-TRIP MEETING'. INFORMATION IS ALSO SENT OUT VIA EMAIL FOR THOSE WHO ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND IN PERSON.
