

# SCHOOL PROFILE 2023

The British International School Bratislava is a non-selective. independent, co-educational day school. It provides a British style education for an international student body. With over 800 students The British International School Bratislava represents over 45 nationalities with approximately 65% European, 25% Asian/Pacific and 10% from other countries. BISB is an IB World School authorised to deliver the IB Diploma Programme as well as the Cambridge International Examinations IGCSE. The British International School Bratislava is registered with the Department for Education (DfE) in the UK as an overseas school. The British International School Bratislava is also accredited by the Ministry of Education of the Slovak Republic and it is included into the network of schools and educational facilities

of the Slovak Republic. Service learning opportunities are provided within the curriculum. Students in all year groups are provided with opportunities to undertake service work within local, provincial and international communities. In Years 12 and 13 IB students are further required to take a leadership role in organizing and running the local service clubs through the CAS elements of their IB. This results in our students developing an acute sense of social responsibility towards other people and the environment on both a local and global scale.

# CURRICULUM AND RESULTS

BISB delivers a curriculum that is both stimulating and challenging, providing a broad and balanced education that is essential in preparing students for the future. The National Curriculum for England forms the framework of the educational programme from Kindergarten to Year 9 (Grade 8). Students then progress to the Cambridge IGCSE in Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10) producing impressive results, comparable to top schools around the world.

We provide the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB) in Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12). The curriculum is based around the IB Leaner Profile and this in term focuses on key approaches to learning which are essential in instilling lifelong learning habits. The IB Diploma scoring system is rated from 1 (poor) to 7 (excellent) with a total of 45 points from 6 subjects including a bonus 3 points from the Extended Essay of 4000 words and a Theory of Knowledge course. There is also a requirement to engage with the CAS (Community, Activity, Service) programme.



### IB AVERAGE SCORE 2011 - 2023




