Applicants will be expected to be able to show strong academic ability or potential. More significantly, however, they should also show a certain flair and independence of mind. They should be engaged, curious, self-reliant and willing to take the initiative. They enjoy difficulty and are both resilient and reflective. They show leadership and empathy as well as being confident in their ability to keep on improving.

Students aged 7 – 11

- Exceptional performance academically (as evidenced by school reports and teacher commendation).
- Involvement in a variety of academic school events /competitions/ presentations (as evidenced by photos, awards, or certificates).
- Participation in regional or internationally recognised competitions (as evidenced by certificates).
- Strong communication skills with an inquisitive mind and an ability to problem solve (as evidenced through interview).

Students aged 11-18

- Exceptional performance academically (as evidenced by school reports and teacher commendation).
- Involvement in a variety of academic school events/competitions/ presentations (as evidenced by photos, awards, or certificates).
- Participation in regional or internationally recognised competitions/conferences (as evidenced by certificates).
- Where applicable: exceptional performance in external examinations e.g. IGCSE or equivalent (as evidenced by certificates).
- Cognitive ability scores in the top 5% of participants nationally or within the available comparative cohorts (e.g. CEM, CAT, MidYis etc).
- Excellent communicator (as evidenced through interview).
- Able to think 'outside the box' and be creative (as evidenced through interview).
