

# SEEK YOUR LIGHT

Laura Medcalf (b. Budapest, 1996), a British - Hungarian multidisciplinary artist. She earned her BA Hons degree in Fine Art in 2018 at the Arts University Bournemouth, United Kingdom.

Medcalf's practice is characterised by the exploration of the transience of the natural environment, meticulously capturing on paper with the involvement of ancient elements such as sand, wind, rivers, seas, and oceans. Inspired by the organic beauty of earth and water. Her work reflects a deep connection with nature, capturing the imprint of rare moments in each piece.

'Seek Your Light' invites viewers on an introspective journey along the ethereal borderlines where the interplay of light, water and natural matter enhances the visual narrative, evoking a sense of wonder.

All the works are created by the border between land and water symbolising a threshold between different states of being, a place of transition, where boundaries blur and new possibilities emerge. Each piece captures this liminality, inviting viewers to reflect on their own experiences of change and transformation.

Light plays a central role in these works, illuminating the surface of the paper and casting shadows that suggest hidden depths of organic forms. The interplay of light and shadow symbolises the interconnection of opposing forces — present and the past, clarity and ambiguity. Through subtle shifts in tonality and contrast, the works evoke a sense of layered mystery.

'Seek Your Light' draws inspiration from the natural world, capturing moments of stillness and serenity along the water's edge. The use of light-sensitive crystals as a paint medium highlights the inherent beauty and magic of the natural environment. Each piece of work becomes a tribute to the awe-inspiring power of nature, inviting viewers to pause and appreciate the subtle wonders that surround them.
