(IGCSE) International General Certificate of Secondary Education

BISC-SL students in Grades 9 and 10 (Years 10 and 11) pursue the IGCSE, a rigorous curriculum that provides a strong foundation in core subjects. It emphasizes understanding and application of knowledge over rote memorization, fostering deeper learning and a better grasp of subjects.

Group 2: Language Acquisition: French, German, Mandarin, Spanish

Group 3: Individuals & Societies, Geography, History, Psychology, Global Politics, Environmental Systems and Societies

Group 4: Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Design Technology, Physics, Sports Exercise and Health Science Mathematics: Analysis and Approaches, Application and Interpretation

Group 6: Biology, Design Technology, Film, Global Politics, Music, Theatre Studies, Visual Arts

Course Routes:

Based on their Year 10-11 performance, students in Years 12 & 13 follow one of three IB course routes:

- 1.) IB Diploma Students study six IB courses, three must be at Higher Level (HL) honors and three at Standard Level (SL).
- 2.) IB Scholar Students study six IB subjects at Standard Level honors or Higher Level. Students may choose a max of 3 HL courses.
- 3.) College Prep, students study a combination of 6 courses at college prep, SL or HL.
