## International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)

BISC-SL students in Grades 9 and 10 (Years 10 and 11) pursue the IGCSE. The IGCSE is an internationally recognized qualification. This British exam-based qualification tests knowledge in individual subjects similar to AP and SAT Subject tests. Universally respected by universities and employers, these qualifications cover a broad range of core subjects and are one of the most academically challenging qualifications currently offered worldwide. Furthermore, the IGCSE builds the skills necessary to study the International Baccalaureate in Grades 11 and 12. University of Cambridge advises that the IGCSE subjects are roughly equivalent to the honors high school curriculum in the U.S.

## International Baccalaureate (IB)

The IB Diploma Programme provides BISC-SL students in Grades 11 & 12 (Years 12 & 13) a balanced and rigorous education that promotes international mindedness. The IB Diploma Programme prepares students for effective participation in a rapidly evolving and increasingly global society as they acquire breadth and depth of knowledge and understanding, studying courses from six subject groups.

Group 1: Literature: English, English Language and Literature

Group 2: Language Acquisition: French, German, Mandarin, Spanish

#### **Course Routes:**

Based on their Grade 9 and 10 performance, students in Grades 11 and 12 follow one of three IB course routes.

IB Diploma Students study six IB subjects, three at Higher Level (HL) honors and three at Standard Level (SL) honors. To receive an IB Diploma, students must receive a minimum of 24 out of 45 points; the worldwide average is 30.2 points and the percentage of students receiving the diploma is 86%.

IB Certificates Students study six IB subjects. Up to six subjects can be at Standard Level honors, with a maximum of three at Higher Level honors. Any of the six subjects not at SL or HL are at the College Prep level.

College Prep Students study six subjects, all at the College Prep level.
