In Pre-Nursery, the children have been experimenting with dry and wet snow and have created artwork using plastic bottles for printing and to make snowmen.















We are sharing the story 'That's Not My Polar Bear' and learning a new song '5 Little Snowmen'. Now all we need is some real snow to fall in Beijing...












YEAR 2: PERFECTING PORTRAITS
