- BSB policy limits students to 10 applications, carefully researched under a “best-fit” philosophy and supported by our university counsellors.



Curriculum

- In Years 10 and 11, students complete the International General Certificate of Education (IGCSE), equivalent in standard to the British GCSE. Students may study from a range of subjects including Language and Literature, Economics, Geography, History, Music, Art, Mathematics, Computer Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Design Technology.
- In Years 12 and 13, students enter the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. Students select one subject from each of the six options, at least 3 (and not more than 4) at higher level (HL), and the remaining at standard level (SL). Students are also required to complete the core components of the IB Diploma, including Theory of Knowledge, Extended Essay, and Creativity, Activity, and Service.
