

What are After-School Activities (ASAs)?

The British School of Guangzhou's After School Activity programme runs every week on Tuesday and Thursday, 3pm-4pm, for students in Years 2-13.

Students have the opportunity to enrich their learning through participation in creative, active, service and academic activities within the after-school programme. These activities will offer variety, inclusivity, fun and enjoyment for our students each week.

Years 2 - 3 students take part in a carousel of creative, active and academic activities throughout each term. They will experience a variety of activities which will enhance and develop their core values of learning. Our students will gain confidence to learn new skills and have fun at the same time.

Year 4 - 13 students get to choose 2 out of hundreds of ASAs. The variety is huge, with everything from performing arts to team sports, charity work to journalism, computer science to robotics!
