## *What are After-School Activities (ASAs)?*

The British School of Guangzhou's After School Activity programme runs every week on Tuesday and Thursday, 3pm–4pm, for students in Years 2–13.

Students have the opportunity to enrich their learning through participation in **creative, active, service and academic** activities within the after-school programme. These activities will offer variety, inclusivity, fun and enjoyment for our students each week.

**Years 2 - 3** students take part in a carousel of creative, active and academic activities throughout each term. They will experience a variety of activities which will enhance and develop their core values of learning. Our students will gain confidence to learn new skills and have fun at the same time.

**Year 4 - 13** students get to choose 2 out of hundreds of ASAs. The variety is huge, with everything from performing arts to team sports, charity work to journalism, computer science to robotics!

From these ASAs, students can go on to represent the school at various events and competitions, such as the Model United Nations, Global Campus Debate League, sports teams, FOBISIA, chess competitions, production and musical performances. They can even be chosen to take part in events connected to our collaborations with The Juilliard School, New York, and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).

### *Years 4-13 Sign Up*

- Students sign up at the beginning of each term for their ASA via the school website ([www.bsg.org.cn](http://www.bsg.org.cn))
- Students select their preferred choice of activities.
- Students get confirmation from their class teacher about which ASA they have been allocated.

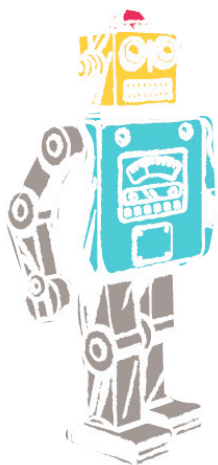


## What activities are on offer?
