



EYFS INTERNATIONAL BILINGUAL CURRICULUM (F1 to F3 - students aged 2 to 5 years old)

We use learning and teaching materials from the highly regarded British Early Years Foundation Stage Framework. The main emphasis for Early Years students is on providing a secure, caring and nurturing environment in which our youngest children love play-based learning and begin to develop holistically into driven, confident and independent individuals.

The EYFS includes seven Areas of Learning.

Our youngest students work towards the seven Early Learning Goals in both Vietnamese and English. Their bilingualism is carefully cultivated through our pioneering phonics programme, that teaches Vietnamese and English phonics using one single approach.

SHAPING GLOBAL CITIZENS WITH A TRULY VIETNAMESE PERSPECTIVE

PRIMARY INTERNATIONAL BILINGUAL CURRICULUM

(Year 1 to Year 6 - students aged 5 to 11 years old)

In Primary we offer a unique international bilingual education which combines the National Curriculum of England and the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) within the learning context of Vietnam.

Our personalised programme gives our students the perfect balance of knowledge and soft skills to become confident and inspired learners, with a clear focus, open minded, and determination in all that they do.

Unique to BVIS, our pioneering phonics programme teaches Vietnamese and English phonics using one single approach to develop our students to be able to seamlessly switch between both English and Vietnamese languages.

Literacy and Maths are the core subjects with the greatest focus in our Primary programme. Delivered in both, some subjects within our IPC Curriculum are taught through thematic studies, and students dive into both English and Vietnamese research to gain a deeper understanding and appreciation in both international and Vietnamese contexts.

Personalised learning is at the heart of what we do at BVIS. We treat your child as an individual by adapting to their personal learning preferences, strengths and areas for growth. We ensure they develop the skills, knowledge and understanding to become successful lifelong learners, preparing them to embark upon their Secondary years feeling empowered, confident and independent.







PREPARING FOR A BRIGHT FUTURE

THE ADAPTED ENGLISH NATIONAL CURRICULUM (Year 7 to Year 9 - students aged 11 to 14 years old)

Our Key Stage 3 curriculum is based on the English National Curriculum with 80% of lessons are taught in English. We remain committed to supporting our students' preserving their own Vietnamese perspective, as global citizens by offering Vietnamese Literature, Vietnamese History and Vietnamese Geography as part of their weekly timetable and delivered in Vietnamese

Our EAL (English as an Additional Language) and VAL (Vietnamese as an Additional Language) support teams allow those who need further English or Vietnamese support to effectively enhance language proficiency in order to fully access our curriculum.

Guided by fully qualified, knowledgeable and experienced subject specialists and with the latest high-quality learning facilities, our students develop an outstanding academic English proficiency and also begin discovering their own unique combination of strengths, skills and passions, which support them well along the next steps in their educational journey into Key Stage 4 (Years 10 and 11).



THE INTERNATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (IGCSE) CURRICULUM

(Year 10 to Year 11 - students aged 14 to 16 years old)

Our Key Stage 4 students take a wide variety of IGCSE courses based upon their individual learning pathways, which lead to IGCSE qualifications. The syllabus and examinations are set and marked by the Cambridge Assessment International Examinations (CAIE).

IGCSEs are widely recognised as the 'gold standard' in examinations for 14 to 16 year old, and are valued by employers and universities all over the world.

As well as offering a balanced curriculum, our IGCSE programme develops academic reading and writing skills, as well as investigation, problem solving, teamwork, recall of knowledge and innovative thinking.

Most IGCSE subjects have both a core and extended curriculum, meaning students of all academic abilities benefit from an appropriate level of challenge so that they can achieve the best results possible.





THE INTERNATIONAL A LEVEL CURRICULUM

(Year 12 to Year 13 - students aged 16 to 18 yeards old)

Our Key Stage 5 students study for International A Levels through their choice from a wide variety of subjects. We use syllabuses from Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) and Pearson Edexcel, both considered the gold standard of academic excellence, and accepted by the top-ranking universities in the world.

BVIS offers an extensive range of A Levels options that allow our students to follow their academic passions. Typically, our students take up to three or four subjects that align with their strengths, interests, passions and future career aspirations to support their university applications. Based on four subject choices, our students have over 1,500 different combinations to choose from.

Focused on personalised learning, our teachers and College and University Guidance Counsellor work closely with individual students to inspire and encourage their learning, perfecting their personal profiles to maximise the possibilities for admission to their first-choice university destination.


OUR VIBRANT COMMUNITY


