

BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD) [grades 10-14]

For our students in grades 10-14, we are implementing a "Bring Your Own Device" (BYOD) policy for personal laptops. The reasons for this are as follows: laptops are better suited to the requirements of classes, and most students already own a laptop in higher grades and prefer to use their own device.

To ensure that learning is not disrupted at the beginning of the school year, it is therefore important that all students come to school ready for classes with the right equipment. This involves having a fully functional laptop.

An Apple computer is strongly recommended to allow students to make the most of our learning environment built around Apple technology. With a MacBook, students can connect their computer to the whiteboard to give presentations and share files with fellow students and teachers. You will find the specifications recommended by the IT department below.

Please ensure that each student is equipped for the next school year by checking their device.
