FLE (French as a Foreign Language)

For 9th to 13th grades

Grade 7th to 11th - US System

In addition to its official diploma courses, Champittet offers a specifically structured programme to learn the French language in its classical foundations and obtain the DELF B2, which allows the student to continue his/her studies in French or to settle in a French-speaking country. In addition, the student will follow a full academic year immersion, with sciences and humanities subjects also in French.

Programme structure

Class groups

Groups levels 9th and 10th FLE and 11th to 13th FLE together

Small class size: maximum 13 students per class

Students are followed by the same teacher during the entire academic year, which provides them with emotional stability

Group effect: Common human adventure for one year

Language immersion

All subjects are taught in French, except Mathematics and English

Francophone environment and reinforced use of the French language at the boarding school

12-13 periods of French per week

Programme Objectives

Develop written and oral competences

Argue and make an essay

Achieve B2 level in June

No prior knowledge of French is required

Validated as the academic school year

Possibility to enter the Swiss Maturité diploma (at the latest by grade 11) or the French Baccalaureate (at the latest by grade 12) after a FLE year if the required level of French is attained

9th to 11th FLE: 12 periods of French per week

FLE programme from 8am to 3.30pm (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday) and Wednesday morning.
