



At the International School of Moscow, our safe and happy Early Years environment is the perfect place for our youngest students to develop and grow. Our specialist teachers will get to know how your child learns best, nurturing their curiosity and interests, as well as guiding their personal, social, and emotional development. We also provide a firm British academic grounding, ensuring your child reaches important milestones in literacy, maths, arts, and design.

Early Years classrooms are specially designed to be bright, vibrant, and full of exciting areas for children to independently explore. Our teachers are experts, with years of experience working with the very youngest children and will guide your child to build their confidence and curiosity about the world around them.

Throughout their Early Years journey, each child will progress through seven key areas of development: Communication and Language; Physical Development; Personal, Social, and Emotional Development; Literacy; Maths; Understanding the World; and Expressive Arts and Design.

Alongside their growth in areas such as mathematics, phonics, and writing - the cornerstones of learning through Primary School and beyond - your child will be introduced to the wonders of music, sports, and foreign languages through specialist lessons in Music, Physical Education, and Russian. Learning is not limited to the classroom, though: our Early Years explorers will take to our our playgrounds, gardens and forests to put learning in context by interacting with the wonders of the natural world.



Our teachers bring learning to life in practical ways through our extra-curricular programme. This includes excursions to local museums and places of interest, as well as – from Year Four – exciting residential trips away from school. Your child will also have access to a range of After-School Activities and community service opportunities.


### CURRICULUM PRIMARY SCHOOL

Our Primary School curriculum sets our students on the path to success. Lessons are lively, challenging, and provide opportunities for our students to think critically and become increasingly independent. Your child will also enjoy exciting, creative, technological, and sporting experiences, learn languages, and will take part in unforgettable outreach activities.

Guided by the English National Curriculum, but adapted to our local and international context, ISM's Primary School curriculum provides a strong academic foundation, as well as offering diverse learning experiences that challenge, engage, and inspire. We nurture personal characteristics and values, too, ensuring every child is supported to grow socially and emotionally.

Throughout their time in Primary School, students delve into a rich Core Curriculum of English, Maths, Science, Art and Design, History, Geography, and Computing, with learning enhanced by specialist lessons in Modern Foreign Languages, Music, and Physical Education. Children also explore their talents in greater depth during special event weeks, such as Art Week and International Week. They develop their performance and public speaking skills during class assemblies and musical productions.

Learners are also praised for practising their "Success Skills", a concept that develops students into well-rounded leaders of tomorrow. ISM's Success Skills are: Resilience, Self-discipline, Balance, Reflection, Independence, Communication, Respect, Creativity, Care and Courage.

Our Secondary School curriculum blends rigorous academic teaching with outstanding care, guidance, and attention. Delving deeper into their chosen subjects, your child will become a knowledgeable, driven learner. Combined, this prepares our students for the challenge of (I)GCSE and beyond.

Our teachers will encourage your child to become a confident, independent learner. In each subject, teachers support students to assess their own work, identify areas for development, and establish their own goals.


Lessons are taught by our subject experts. Students study English, Maths, Sciences, Geography, History, Drama, Art, Russian Language, Computing, Music, and PE (Physical Education). Your child will also choose one other foreign language. In each subject, they will be supported to assess their own work, identify areas for development, and establish clear goals.

Your child will also be supported by their Form Tutor, who has the important pastoral role of coordinating all aspects of their academic and social development. Students in Secondary School are provided with an Apple MacBook of their own to use for schoolwork, which teaches them responsibility and fosters independence.

Challenging, engaging, and packed with outstanding learning experiences, our Secondary School education provides a broad and balanced education that prepares our students for their future.



By Year 10, our students typically study nine or ten subjects as they prepare for the important (I)GCSE exams. Our teachers will help students choose their specialist subjects, based on their academic strengths and goals, as well as their ambitions for the future.

The A-Level curriculum at the International School of Moscow sets an exceptionally high standard, providing pathways to outstanding higher education across the world. At Sixth Form, your child will specialise in three or four subjects, as well as expanding their knowledge and skills through leadership, outreach, and extra-curricular opportunities. Equipped with the confidence, character, and resilience to succeed, our students achieve exceptional academic results that take them to first-choice universities across the world.

At Sixth Form, our students delve deeper into their chosen subjects. As they prepare for university – and start thinking about careers - they become specialists in their fields, typically studying four AS-Level subjects in Year 12 and three A-Level subjects in Year 13.

We offer more than 20 subjects at A-Level, including Art & Design, Music, Maths and Further Maths, Economics, Sciences, English Literature, Russian and many more.

As is the case at every stage of a student's education at ISM, their academic studies are only one part of their educational experience. We encourage all our students to learn beyond the classroom by pursuing their interests and embarking on new adventures. We organise trips and expeditions, provide a variety of community service opportunities, and offer a plethora of activities, including sports, volunteering, music, drama, dance, and languages.

### GLOBAL CAMPUS

Our innovative Global Campus digital learning platform offers personalised learning and connects our students with peers from other Nord Anglia schools worldwide. Age-specific sections provide a range of learning materials, including Forest School, STEAM with MIT (Massachusetts Institute Of Technology), Social Impact projects with UNICEF, Performing Arts opportunities through Juilliard, a Writers Corner, university advice, and health and wellbeing resources to encourage creativity, critical thinking and personal growth.

### Massachusetts Institute of Technology

The MIT-Nord Anglia STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) programme develops our students' problem-solving skills through real-world challenges that get them thinking outside the box.

Our global programme inspires students to look beyond individual subjects, sparking their curiosity through our hands-on interdisciplinary approach to problemsolving. Guided by the world's leading STEAM institution, our students take part in challenges and visit MIT on a trip led by experts from the university. Our collaboration also gives our teachers the opportunity to learn from specialists in the world of STEAM, producing cutting-edge lessons that inspire our students in the future.

### unicef 🚱 | for every child

Students are challenged to make a difference both locally and internationally, working together to support the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

Our collaboration with UNICEF challenges both students and teachers to think about how they can make a meaningful, positive impact on the world around them. This includes embedding the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) in our teaching and learning, and using materials developed by UNICEF. Our students also take part in an annual Global Challenge, as well as local outreach opportunities in our community.

### Juilliard

Collaborating with The Juilliard School, the world-renowned performing arts conservatory, we recognise the creative potential of the Performing Arts to ignite students' imaginations, boost their self-confidence, and improve their academic performance. Our Dance, Drama and Music classes are enhanced by Juilliard's expertise, and our teachers have access to curated professional development and an online collection of educational resources via the Juilliard Creative Classroom, enriching their teaching. Your child will be inspired to experiment, create, improvise, and perform independently, fostering resilience and a growth mindset.





On entry to our school, each student is allocated a House. Members of the same family are placed into the same House, and students belong to their House throughout their education at ISM.

From Pre-Nursery to Year 13, belonging to an ISM House is what unites our students across ages. The House becomes a second family, with House leaders in place to lead House events and look after new members.

We always seek a balance of male and female students in each House across all year groups.

The House names and colours are as follows:





The House System is made up of two parts: Merits and House Points, and Competitions.

The Merit and House Point system is for students to gain points for individual awards relating to their progress and effort in all aspects of school life.

Our Inter-House competitions, such as Sports Days, Swimming Galas, and Poetry and Music Competitions, give students the opportunity to represent their House and win special awards as a team.
