

## NAISR NECIS TEAM ATHLETIC AGREEMENT

This agreement is required by all student-athletes and is valid for the duration of a student's entire enrollment at NAISR. The agreement is to ensure that students, parents and/or guardians have a complete understanding of the expectations involved in a student becoming a member of a NECIS Team.

## **Student/Athlete Agreement**

Congratulations on becoming a member of a Nord Anglia International School Rotterdam Athletic Team! Being a student-athlete is a privilege, and with privileges come responsibilities. NAISR student-athletes must comply with the following expectations and responsibilities:

- **1. Athletes will perform to the best of their abilities in all classes.** You are a student first and an athlete second. Failing to complete assignments, submit work on time, or maintaining an acceptable level of academic performance indicates an inability to handle the pressures of being a team member as well as a student. If teachers are not satisfied that you are working to your potential, you may be suspended from competition until improvement is shown.
- **2.** Athletes will attend and be on time for all classes, practices and games. Any player who has missed academic classes during the day will not be permitted to train or compete in games.

If a student-athlete misses 2 practices without a valid reason, he/she will be suspended for one game. If a student-athlete is late for practices or games 4 times during the season he/she will be suspended for a game.

- **3.** Athletes are expected to demonstrate citizenship and leadership in all classes. This includes showing respect to teachers and other students, demonstrating cooperation, and responsible behavior at all times. Behavior should not interfere with the learning opportunities of others.
- 4. Athletes will commit to participate fully in the Athletics Programme at NAISR. This includes:
  - a) Committing to all practices, games and team experiences
  - b) Committing to the team until the end of the season, unless mutually agreed upon by the coach and student-athlete
  - c) Conducting themselves in a manner that displays respect for coaches, teammates, game officials, and opponents
  - d) Making arrangements to fully take care of all necessary fees
  - e) Taking good care of uniforms and equipment.
- 5. Athletes are expected to abide by all the NECIS governing By-Laws in association with their on court and tournament conduct.



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I, as a student-athlete at NAISR, recognize that there are high expectations for my conduct both during competitions and as a student. I agree to adhere to the above expectations, and understand that if at any time I do not live up to the terms of this contract and the code of conduct, my participation may be restricted or terminated. I further understand that should this occur I forfeit any fees paid and will not be reimbursed.
