OVERVIEW

St Andrews International School Bangkok was founded in 1997 on an attractive location right in the centre of the city's amenities and transport links. In August 2017, our High School moved and expanded into a second site, conveniently located on Sukhumvit Road.

We are a co-educational international school and part of Nord Anglia Education, an organisation of over 80 schools in more than 31 countries committed to providing the best of the world's educational practices. St Andrews Bangkok is a truly inclusive school that welcomes students of all abilities. Our support programme caters to students with additional learning needs so that they can remain within the mainstream curriculum. At the same time, our high performing students aiming to reach ever-higher levels of achievement find the teachers and resources they need to realise their potential.

CAMPUS AND FACILITIES

Our school was founded in 1997 on a charming and spacious location right in the centre of the city's amenities and transport links. In August 2017, our High School moved to a second campus, conveniently located on Sukhumvit Road. This expansion enabled our original campus to offer more uniquely tailored learning spaces to meet the needs and interests of our Primary School students. At the same time, our enhanced High School facilities are designed to inspire and prepare students for a broader range of higher educational pursuits and career opportunities.

STUDENTS AND FACULTY

Our student body comprises over 2,200 students between Primary School and High School. Students may start at St Andrews Bangkok in Foundation Stage from age two, and continue until they graduate from Year 13. Nearly 60 nationalities are represented at St Andrews Bangkok. Thai nationals account for approximately 50% of our students. This diverse range of backgrounds nurtures an environment of open-mindedness and acceptance of other cultures and abilities. We have a team of highly qualified, experienced teaching and support staff who are dedicated to getting the best from the children in their care.

YEARS 10 & 11 IGCSE PROGRAMME

Years 10 and 11 students study for the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course examinations. All students study Mathematics, English, English Literature and at least one Science subject, and they choose from among the other subjects, usually following eight or nine IGCSE courses in total.
