Our parent teacher group at BIS is a welcoming group of parents which brings the community at our school together and makes connections between parents, teachers and students. It is one more way to meet and talk with campus leadership teams.

Our two dedicated PTG's, Primary and Secondary, work together throughout the year on whole school events as well as running campus specific activities.

We organise events such as family events, workshops with parents and students, and gifts for our teachers. We also support our community partners with donations which have been raised over the year.

There are many ways to do this, but some examples include serving as a contact for new families joining your child's class, coordinating class social play dates or parents meet ups and promoting PTG events.

COUNTRY REPRESENTATIVES

As a Country Representative, you are the point of contact for any new families wanting to connect with others from the same home country, or a country they may have previously lived, and an important role in the spectacular International Day and International Week (a.k.a "Global Cafe") which is considered a highlight event of the year!

Parent volunteers are needed for helping with the activities, goody bags, ticket sales





At this event we have exclusive and valuable raffle prices. In 2023 we raised 189,750,000 vnd for charity and we handed the money to Anh Minh School for the Hearing Impaired. This generous contribution will have a major impact on helping to build a brand new, multipurpose basketball and badminton court.
